Steve Schimp gave an update on yesterday's Sanitary District meeting. The board's position is that the developers have to pay their share to help pay for the expansion of the current plant, as it is now maxed out. They also have to pay their share for the new proposed plant, called the South Fork.

Harleigh Winkler spoke and shared his idea of a proposed plan he recommends as an alternative connector between Mt. Ranch Road and Highway 49. It was moved and seconded that we as Citizens for San Andreas draft a proposal to CCOG to look at alternatives for a direct route, specifically this one that Harleigh had proposed. A vote was taken and approved that we will submit this proposal in Harleigh's name to CCOG.
