

CITIZENS FOR SAN ANDREAS MEETING
JANUARY 10, 2008

Jim Kavanagh opened the meeting with the first item on the agenda, Pat Guttman's presentation of the final draft of our vision statement. Comments were very positive. It was moved and seconded that we adopt the vision statement as it now stands.

Zerrill Mc Daniel presented the proposed map boundaries for the San Andreas community plan. She stated that we want to encourage well-planned growth in our present San Andreas 9 square mile boundary. If we use the fire district boundary it also gives us surrounding open space. We can note the outer boundary as our sphere of influence.

Arlene Weissman asked to hear a discussion on the pros and cons of incorporation. Maybe at a future meeting.

Lynn O'Conner suggested we talk face to face personally with the major land owners about the proposed boundary, and document it. Stephanie Moreno stated that if we adopt the larger boundary as our community center we may be fighting off unwanted growth. She also stated that we need to have good policies to maintain our open space.

Tyler Summerset presented an update on the San Andreas Rural Livable Community Grant. It is a transportation planning grant and is linked to the General Plan. There will be a steering committee working together at meetings with Tyler, and Tim Mc Sorley to decide what we want to accomplish with this grant. The steering committee will in turn present their decisions to the community.

Tyler shared that we have to move quickly as we have deadlines to meet with Caltrans and the General Plan. He stated that he will be contacting the committee members within 2 weeks and the process will begin.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:40 Pm. The next meeting will be on February 6th at St. Andrews Church Hall in San Andreas at 5:30 PM.
